Order: CoFC-2025-005
Effective Date: This Order takes effect at 12:00 noon Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on July 17, 2025 and remains in force until the earlier of 12:00 noon Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) Friday October 31, 2025 or until the Order is rescinded.

***Prohibition Area A prohibits the following:**

- Category 1 fires (campfires) as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
- Category 2 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
- Category 3 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
- Sky lanterns
- Wood fired hot tubs, wood fired pizza ovens and other wood fired devices unless vented through a structure that has a flue and is incorporated in a building
- Binary Exploding Targets
- Fireworks, as defined in the *Fireworks Act*
- Burn barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description
- Air Curtain Burners
- Carbonizers
- Controlled Air Incinerators

***Prohibition Area B prohibits the following:**

- Category 2 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
- Category 3 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
- Binary Exploding Targets
- Fireworks, as defined in the *Fireworks Act*
- Burn barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description
- Air Curtain Burners
- Carbonizers
- Controlled Air Incinerators
