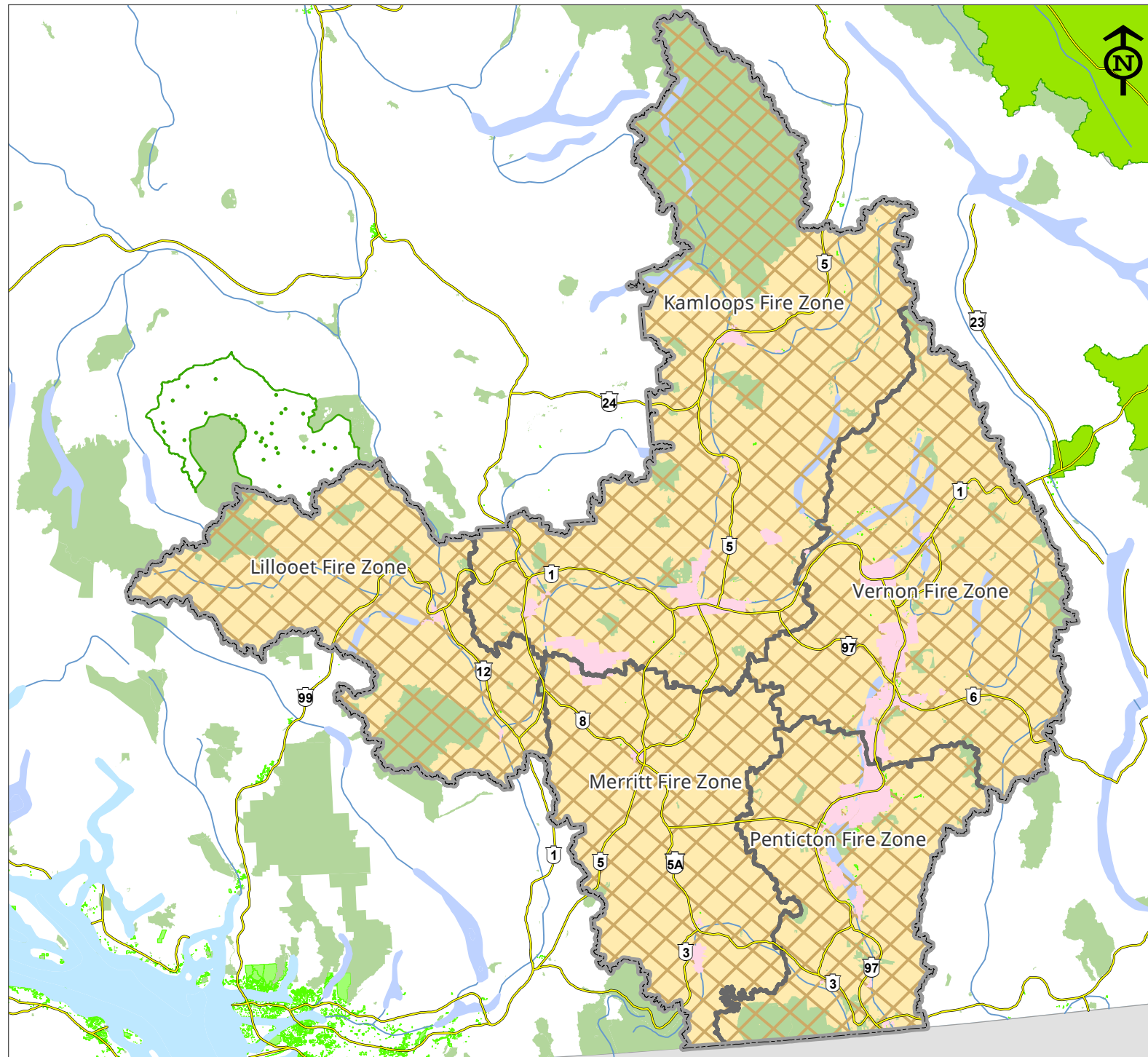
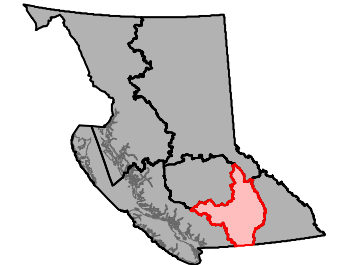




Kamloops Fire Centre Prohibition Areas

Effective Date: These Orders take effect at 12:00 noon Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on August 10, 2026, and remains in force until the earlier of 12:00 noon Pacific Daylight Time (PDT) on October 9, 2026 or until the Order is rescinded.

- *Prohibition Area restricts the following:**
- Category 1 campfires as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
 - Category 2 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
 - Category 3 open fire as defined in the *Wildfire Regulation*
 - The operation of any Off-Road Vehicle (ORV), for recreational purposes on Crown land, as defined in the *Off-Road Vehicle Act* and further prescribed in section 2 (a) all-terrain vehicles, (b) motorcycles and (c) off-road side-by-side vehicles, of the *Off-Road Vehicle Regulation*, with the exception of (d) snowmobiles and (e) on-highway motor vehicles.
 - Air Curtain Burners
 - Carbonizers
 - Fireworks, as defined in the *Fireworks Act* of BC
 - Binary Exploding Targets
 - Burn Barrels or Burn Cages of any size or description
 - Controlled air incinerators
 - Sky lanterns
 - Wood fired hot tubs, wood fired pizza ovens and other wood fired devices unless vented through a structure that has a flue and is incorporated in a building

BC Wildfire Prohibitions (fire bans) and restrictions are made under Sec 10, 11, 12 of the *Wildfire Act*. Prohibitions and restrictions apply to all land described in the legal order. Municipalities regulate open fire within their boundaries. This data does not show municipal prohibitions or restrictions, so please check with local municipality for any other restrictions before lighting any fire.
