Extracurricular – New for the 2025/26 School Year

Extracurricular transportation funding will no longer be allocated to each school district automatically. Extracurricular funding may be requested for up to the same allocation received in 2024/25 as indicated in the 2025/26 Policy and Procedures Guide.

School districts are asked to hold any remaining Extracurricular carryover in order to meet the anticipated demand of To/From Transportation costs in future years.

If there are unused Extracurricular funds within the school district by the end of the 2024/25 school year, the Joint Transportation Committee may direct the school district to repurpose any remaining carryover funding to address To/From Transportation costs and/or Extracurricular requests for the 2025/26 school year.
