Topics range from student enrolment and demographics to experiences and outcomes.

The goal is to build district capacity in using data and evidence. To help do this, districts can provide comments and ask questions about the Ministry's analytical tools. Additionally, districts are encouraged to share how they are using their local and Ministry-provided data to improve student success.

HOW IT WORKS

Superintendents will receive an invitation to each session via the Deputy Minister's Bulletin and are encouraged to attend these sessions and invite staff as they deem appropriate. Attendees are asked to review the report for each session in advance and come ready with comments and questions.
